



Standards for Maintenance of CEUs in Certification

The *new* **Standards for Maintenance of Continuing Education Units in Certification** are effective January 1, 2004 for members and non-members whose maintenance cycle begins January 1, 2004.

Examples of how these new standards apply to single and multiple credentialed individuals are as follows:

Single Credential Holders:

CCA =	20 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
CCS =	20 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
CCS-P =	20 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
RHIT =	20 CEUs
RHIA =	30 CEUs
CHP =	30 CEUs
CHPS =	30 CEUs

Multiple Credential Holders:

RHIT + (CCS-P or CCS) =	30 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
CCS + CCS-P =	30 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments per coding credential)
RHIA + (CCS-P or CCS) =	40 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
RHIT + CHP =	40 CEUs
RHIA + CHPS =	40 CEUs
CHP + (CCS-P or CCS) =	40 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
RHIT + CCS + CCS-P =	40 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments per coding credential)
RHIA + CCS + CCS-P =	50 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments per coding credential)
CHPS + CCS + RHIA =	50 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments)
RHIT + CCS + CCS-P + CHP =	60 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments per coding credential)
RHIA + CCS + CCS-P + CHPS =	60 CEUs (includes 2 self-assessments per coding credential)
