

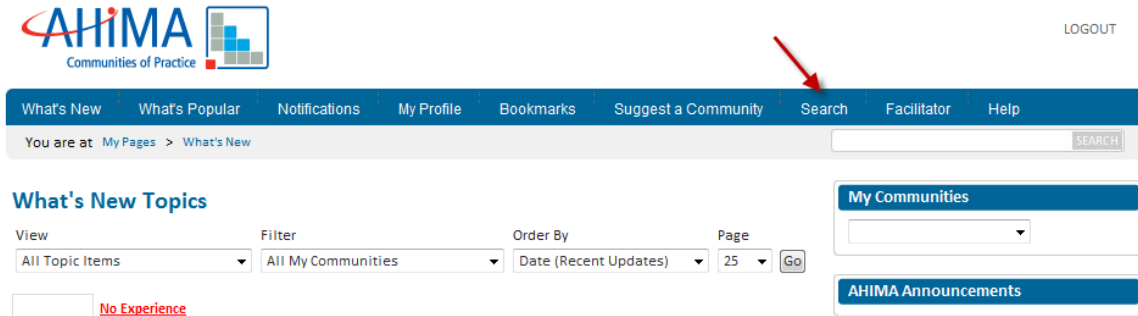


Joining Communities Tips for joining or unjoining Communities

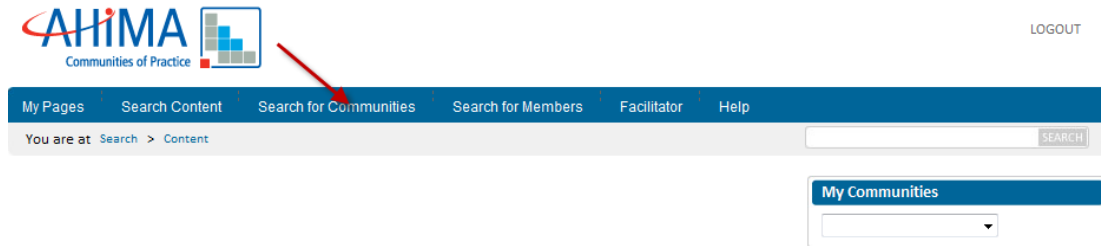
It is easy to join any of the over 140 public communities either from the Search, Search for Communities or from the community itself.

Search, Search for Communities

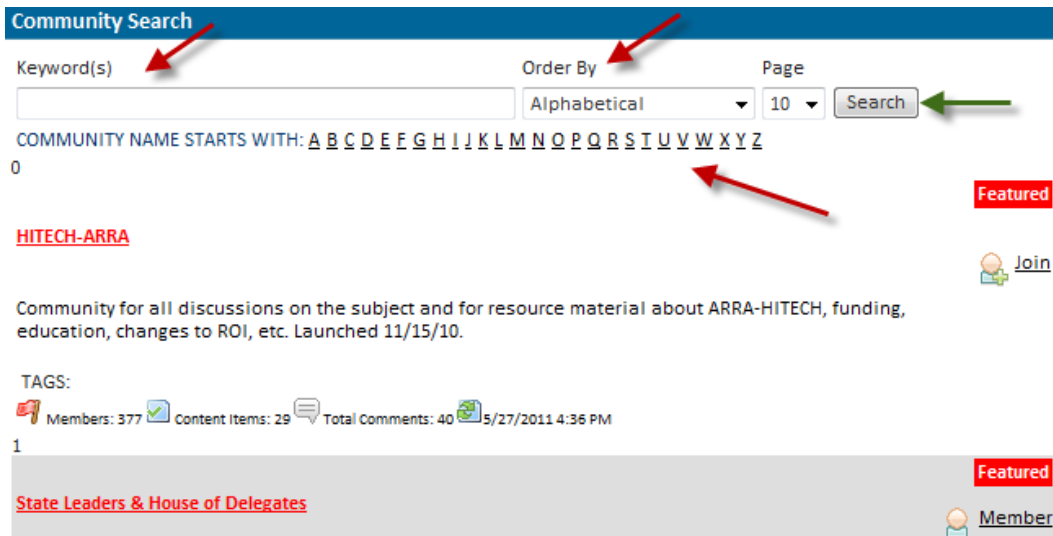
To join or unjoin, choose the Search on the top toolbar.



Choose Search for Communities from this toolbar.



The screen will open to the communities that are **Featured**. These may be new or communities with hot topics.



There are four ways you can find communities under the **Search for Communities**.

1. **Keyword Search**—You can type in a keyword(s) and come up with a list of communities that the keywords are within.
