Experience in leading organization-wide information intensive initiatives such as enterprise information management, data governance, implementation of EHRs, privacy, security. Senior level consulting experience with healthcare leadership on organization-wide, information intensive initiatives

Clinical Diagnosis and Procedure Coding – Requirements:

AHIMA Membership, RHIA/RHIT, CCS and/or CCS-P, AHIMA Approved ICD-10-CM & PCS Trainer

Five+ years of coding training experience – inpatient and outpatient

Five+ years of coding audit experience – inpatient and outpatient

Experience with CDI, coding, and billing/revenue cycle continuum

Proficiency in coding in both ICD-10-CM & PCS and ICD-9-CM
