## CCA Exam Allowable Code Books

Effective May 1, 2018

All candidates are required to bring the following code books to the test center:

### REQUIRED:

1. ICD-10-CM code book (2018)
2. ICD-10-PCS code book (2018)
3. CPT code book (2018) - AMA only

### OPTIONAL: 2018 ICD-10-CM Guidelines for Coding and Reporting

Note: These materials may be spiral bound, softbound, compact softbound, in hard cover form or in a ring binder.

Candidates who do not bring the correct codebooks to the test center will not be allowed to test and forfeit their exam fees. The allowable codebooks are listed below and include the ICD-10-CM/PCS and AMA CPT.

Note: Although not required, candidates may bring a medical dictionary to the test center.
