## AHIMA Approved Continuing Education Program

We are excited to announce we are making updates to the AHIMA Approved Continuing Education Program. These changes will align with the Commission on Certification for Health Informatics and Information Management (CCHIIM) requirements for qualifying CEU activities and will implement new, more accurate standards for organizations authorized to provide AHIMA CEUs.

As an AHIMA continuing education provider, we want to communicate advance notice of these updates and how they may affect your future applications with AHIMA. Following are important updates that will be **coming in September 2021:**

- **New Submission Site:** The new submission site will be enhanced with tools that will allow providers to login and update their account, company contacts, and ability to save applications
- **New Fees:** To provide an increased focus on the quality of education, AHIMA has updated the program fee structure to support the growing needs of the program. The new fee structure will be coming in September 2021
- **Discontinuing Annual Fee:** To offer CEU providers with a more cost-effective way to apply for AHIMA continuing education units (CEUs), the annual fee will no longer be required
- **Teaching Methods:** AHIMA has expanded the different categories of teaching methods to better reflect the learning environment
- **Post-Program Materials:** AHIMA-approved continuing education providers will be required to upload program attendee lists and an evaluation summary for each approved program. This new process will allow AHIMA to auto-generate CEU certificates for approved provider program participants
