## Prepare for Your Component Association Hill Day Event with the Best Practices Checklist.



At the AHIMA22 Global Conference, AHIMA advocacy leaders were invited to attend a roundtable discussion to share "best practices" for organizing and conducting a state-level Hill Day. We have developed a "Best Practices Checklist" based on that discussion and are excited to share it with AHIMA Component Association (CA) leaders and AHIMA advocacy leaders.

## Component Association Hill Day Best Practices Checklist

- 1. Utilize Short Videos
  - Try to keep your videos under three minutes
  - · Share short videos on social media to engage and educate members
- 2. Ask others to share your videos on their social media channels
- 3. Build Relationships to Advance the Health Information Profession
  - Partner with other organizations with similar interests (for example, the state chapter of the Healthcare Financial Management Association or a state hospital association)
  - Join forces with local healthcare partners
  - Schedule a CA Hill Day event to introduce the association and members to your legislators, not necessarily to discuss issues
- 4. Provide an Advocacy Update at Your CA Annual Meeting
- 5. Use State Legislative Websites to Follow State Bills
- 6. Get Organized: Plan Your CA Hill Day Event
- 7. Contact the governor's office to learn your state's process for putting together a Hill Day event
  - Consider planning an introduction day (either in person or virtual) before sending members to meet with legislators for the Hill Day event
- 8. Leverage Member Surveys
  - Survey members to learn what is important to them
  - · Survey members to learn what advocacy-related issues interest them the most
- Reach Out: Establish Ongoing Communication with State Legislators and Representatives
  - Introduce your CA's advocacy team and explain the association's mission
  - · Start relationship building and keep the conversation going
  - Introduce the state CA
  - Just introduce yourselves: you don't need to be communicating about a specific issue to establish communication
  - Relate to your legislators on a personal level with stories about your own experiences with health information, such as using telehealth or difficulty sharing records between doctors
- 10. Involve Student Members
  - Invite student members to your Hill Day event
  - Include students in advocacy efforts
- 11. Hold a Zoom Meeting with Your Advocacy Team
  - Hold meetings on a quarterly basis at minimum
  - Use the meeting time to brainstorm ideas
- 12. Provide a Framework for Legislators
  - Include a story, bullet points, and that CAs are a resource
- 13. Provide Easy, Actionable Items for CA Members
